During GRAP Stage 3, the following activities are banned:

- 1. Earthwork for excavation and filling, including boring and drilling works.
- 2. Piling works.
- 3. All demolition works.
- 4. Laying of sewer lines, water lines, drainage, and electric cabling by open trench system.
- 5. Brick/masonry works.
- 6. Operation of RMC batching plants.
- 7. Major welding and gas-cutting operations.
- 8. Painting, polishing, and varnishing works.
- 9. Cement, plaster, and other coatings, except minor indoor repairs.
- 10. Cutting/grinding and fixing of tiles, stones, and other flooring materials, except minor indoor repairs.
- 11. Waterproofing work (excluding chemical waterproofing).
- 12. Road construction activities and major repairs.
- 13. Transfer, loading/unloading of dust-generating materials like cement, fly-ash, bricks, etc.
- 14. Movement of vehicles carrying construction materials on unpaved roads.
- 15. Any transportation of demolition waste.
- 16. Operations of stone crushers.
- 17. All mining and associated activities.
- 18. Restrictions on BS III petrol and BS IV diesel LMVs in specified districts.
- 19. Restrictions on Delhi-registered diesel MGVs of BS-III standards or below.
- 20. Prohibition of BS-III and below diesel LCVs entering Delhi (except for essential services).
- 21. Restrictions on inter-state buses to Delhi (except CNG/BS-VI diesel, and those with All India Tourist Permit).

These measures aim to control dust and air pollution during severe air quality conditions.
