

CREDAI National Introduction

CREDAI was established in 1999 and is the apex body representing 13,000 private Real Estate developers spread across 21 states 230 city chapters in India. It is a not-for-profit company registered under Section 25 of Companies Act, 1956 which seeks to create a favourable policy climate to ensure housing for all. CREDAI has become the preferred platform with regard to national discourse on Housing and Habitat through strong networking with Government, Policy Makers, Investors, Financial Institutions and Real Estate Developers. It is the prime knowledge-sharing forum for latest industry data, technological advancements, and industry benchmarks.



In a first ever initiative of Real Estate, CREDAI has launched a business forum called CREDAI Women's Wing with a long term aim of making this industry gender neutral. CREDAI Women's Wing will make an effort towards increased leadership of women within Real Estate. Currently we are having more than 1500 CWW members across India.

Real Estate has largely been an industry for men, a sector that demands hard physical labour and daily dealing with an unorganized work force. As a result, the industry has seldom seen active participation from women.

CREDAI National launched its W omen's Wing in April 2017 at the hands of Hon. Vice President of India, Shri. Venkaiah Naidu, Hon. Chief Minister of Gujarat Shri Vijay Rupani, Shri. Shankar Chaud hary Hon. Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare, Medical Education, Environment and Urban Development, Government of Gujarat, then CREDAI Chairman Mr Getamber Anand, CREDAI President Mr Jaxay Shah and CREDAI President Elect Mr Satish Magar.

CREDAI Women's Wing will provide a strong networking forum and also create an incubation program to encourage more active women participation in this industry. This initiative has received tremendous response from across the country.

Diversity a dire need In real estate

Inclusive Approach

The industry that builds homes for a population in which 50% are women, should have an inclusive approach, and as many women leaders leading these business houses of construction as possible. The expertise of women in areas like Planning, Designing, Sales & Marketing, Finance, Legal,

Quality Control, Liaising, and Customer Facing Departments etc. can help define and execute numerous growth-driven strategies that are instrumental in elevating their brand. Also women are considered to be in a better position to understand the needs and sentiments of female home buyers, and hence can effectively establish and nurture a long-lasting relationship with female customers and investors.

Perception Re-Alignment

In the recent times women have helped build image of their companies and stimulate sales, by strengthening the trust factor in the minds of the buyer. Women are perceive to be more approachable by buyers, and companies with women directors or partners generate value by broadening market vision and enhancing board dynamics. Active participation of women developers can hence help build the overall perception of developers in the real estate industry.

Emotional Quotient

Women have a high emotional quotient and are able to connect with their customers better thus leaving room for less trust deficit. Real estate traditionally has been projected and perceived as sweat and physical hard work on the field,

site visits, long hours and travel not to add its inherent malpractice has very closely been associated with human-male qualities like sustenance, strength and struggle. But while real estate is solid and tangible, there is great emotional quotient involved in the buying decision of a home.

Empowering Women Leadership

CREDAI aims to give women entrepreneurs from the real estate sector more power and responsibilities in the decision making process of CREDAI activities and Committees. The Women's Wing will bring together women developers, and

empower them by enhancing their business related knowledge and skill set. It will provide a platform to ideate with each other on real estate topics and help problem sharing of all women developers in the city.

Risk Mitigation

In the event that one family member is indisposed or befalls a tragedy, the women should be in a position to step up and take the reins as the situation demands, with the confidence that she needs. The Women's Wing will introduce the

departments, functions and activities of a real estate business to women who are currently not involved in the business. This will facilitate their entry in the business in difficult times, or when necessary.

The guiding principle

The CREDAI City Chapter Women's Wing is a subcommittee and an integral part of the CREDAI City Chapter main body. It was formed with the key objective of encouraging women developers to participate actively in their family owned Real Estate business, and in CREDAI City Chapter activities and benefit from it. This is a business forum aimed at encouraging and incorporating gender diversity in the leadership of Real Estate.

Members of Women's Wing will be a two categories :

1. Women who are ACTIVE in business

Women's Wing will provide a Network Forum geared towards advance Real Estate Leadership

and more technical aspects of the business. This group will also be actively involved in other committees within CREDAI City Chapter.

2. Women who are NOT INVOLVED in the business but have the desire and potential

The Women's Wing along with the City President will provide an incubation cell which will create a learning program to cater to the easing of these women into the industry with ease and confidence. Trainings, Session, Site Visits, Experts from the industry and allied industry will be roped in for this cause. The sequence of subjects that this incubation cell should follow are listed in Annexure 1
